Our members include manufacturers, service providers, property owners and managers with an interest in promoting a "Green Lifestyle" of conservation and accountability.



Ratio Utility Billing System (RUBS) is an acceptable practice for cost allocation where metering is impractical or not economically feasible. RUBS' cost allocation may be calculated on any method that fairly and consistently allocates costs.
